

NLU, Unicef team up for child rights

Guwahati: The National Law University (NLU), Assam, recently signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Unicef, Assam, on the Centre for Child Rights (CCR) based in NLU.

“The CCR was established on March 14, 2015, in NLU with the intention of creating a knowledge hub on child rights and child protection in the north-

east. It is best placed to work with both the judiciary and the executive in Assam and the region,” said a joint statement issued by NLU and Unicef.
