4.8.3 Activities of Important Committees

The academic environment has improved with imparting quality legal education with the result that not even a single case of malpractice or unfair means has been reported during the period under report. The Committee has undertaken special surprise visits during examinations to keep a strict vigilance on any unfair means or malpractice. The University is equipped with Anti-Plagiarism software which examines all the project reports and the dissertations submitted by the students. The software filters the contents of the project reports in accordance with the standards of National Law University, Assam Academic Misconduct Regulations. There was not even a single case of violation of these Regulations during the period.

7. CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE

The National University and Judicial Academy Assam has shifted in the month of January, 2017 to the new campus situated in a beautiful landscape facing massive Brahmaputra River with an imposing hill in the background in a sprawling 150 bighas of land in Amingaon.

The University new campus at Amingaon was inaugurated on March 25, 2017 in the presence of galaxy of dignitaries: Sri Sarbananda Sonowal, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam; Hon'ble Mr. Justice J. Chelameswar, Judge, Supreme Court of India; Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sharad Arvind Bobde, Judge, Supreme Court of India; Hon'ble Mr. Justice Abhay Manohar Sapre, Judge, Supreme Court of India; Hon'ble Mr. Justice Amitava Roy, Judge, Supreme Court of India; Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajit Singh, Chief Justice of Gauhati High Court and Chancellor of National Law University, Assam; and Sri V. K. Pipersania, Chief Secretary, Government of Assam.



The inaugural function was graced by the Hon'ble High Court Judges of Gauhati High Court, Registrar General of the High Court, Registrars and Officers of the High Court, Judicial Officers, Additional Chief Secretary, Law Secretary, DGP, DC, SP, other government officers, PWD officials, Teaching and Non-teaching staff, students of NLUJAA, members of the press and media.





The Moot Court Hall is well equipped like regular Courts with seating capacity of 150 students. In addition, sufficient number of meeting rooms, discussion lounges, faculty rooms, separate common rooms for boys and girls, counselling room, Legal Aid Clinic, other Academic Centres with all modern amenities are housed in the Academic Block.



Adjacent to the Academic Block is Administrative Block equipped with modern facilities housing the VC's Office, Offices of the Registrar, Finance Officer, Deputy Registrar, Assistant Registrar, Administrative Section, Examination Section, Accounts Section, IT & Engineering Sections and all other support offices.



Adjacent to VC's Office there is Conference Hall with excellent IT arrangements for conducting meeting of Academic Council, Executive Council, General Council and other bodies. Well-furnished Judges Lounge, Conference Hall with seating capacity of 150 students to conduct national and international conferences, seminar, and workshops with excellent world class facilities are also housed in the same building

On the top floor of Administrative Block the University Library is housed as a temporary measure. It will be shifted to an independent customised building once construction of the Central Library is completed.

National Law University, Assam has a well-equipped Health Centre to provide first aid and basic medical facilities. To tackle any kind of medical emergency the University owns an ambulance which is available 24x7. Counselling Centre has been established to provide holistic support to the students by to address issues relating to academic and non-academic stress and anxiety, and to foster positive behaviour and personality development. The University infrastructures are Specially Abled Persons friendly.



There are two Hostels for the students, Boys Hostel and Girls Hostel. The combined hostels seats is 300, each hostel having 150 seats. At the hostel students are provided individual bed, study table and chair with internet facility in each room. The hostels are equipped with smokeless kitchen, spacious dining area, reading hall, gymnasium, yoga, prayer hall and library room etc.

National Law University, Assam has a well-equipped 33 KV power sub-station with a dedicated electricity connection. There is a 500 KV Diesel Generator set installed in the power house for uninterrupted power supply in the campus. There is also Solar Back up power of 5 KV in each building.

8. ACTIVITIES AND AMENITIES OF IT DEPARTMENT

- The NKN Internet bandwidth upgraded from 100 Mbps to 1 Gbps with increased demand of online activities by the University fraternity in month of June, 2016.
- New Computer Lab of the capacity of 45 numbers of Computers is setup at the 1st floor of the Administrative building of the Campus.
- One ISDN PRI link of 2 Mbps is procured from BSNL for telephone connectivity at the permanent campus.
- New YouTube Channel and social media pages of NLUJAA has been created to upload photographs and videos of Events, Seminars and Special Lectures.
- Academic and Administrative building are entirely covered with Wi-Fi Network.
- Internet Connectivity to New Girls and Boys hostel is enabled via optical fibre.
- A two day workshop on A-VIEW (Amrita Virtual Interactive E-Learning World) was conducted on 10th and 11th March, 2017. The aim of workshop was the hands-on training especially for the faculty members encouraging to perform online and distance education to be offered by the University.

9.3 Ph.D. Programme

National Law University, Assam advertised for admission to Ph.D. Programme on November 3, 2015. The last date for the submission of filled-in form was November 30, 2015 and with late fee of Rs.500/- till December 4, 2015. The University had received a total number of 47 applications and out of which 10 candidates were exempted from appearing for the written test as per the University Ph.D. Regulations. A total number of 37 candidates were called for the written examination out of which 33 candidates were from Law background and one each from Business Administration, Chartered Accountancy, Journalism and Mass Communication and Political Science. The written test was held on December 6, 2015 in which 35 candidates appeared for the test. The qualifying marks for the written test for General and OBC candidates is 55% and for SC and ST candidates it is 50%. A total number of 19 candidates qualified the written test. Hence, a total number of 29 candidates (those who were exempted from the written test were 10 and qualified in written test 19), were called for Viva-Voce on their preliminary research proposal before the Research Committee. In furtherance Research Methodology related orientations, classes, submission of sixth monthly report etc. had also been initiated till the submission of the report.

NLUA LAW & POLICY REVIEW is a faculty run peer reviewed Journal published biannually by the National Law University, Assam (Guwahati). The primary objective of the Journal is to serve as an important academic forum for legal scholarship. The NLUALPR encourages critical thinking and is an earnest attempt to provide an effective research tool by igniting erudite debates among research scholars, jurists, students, members of civil society and thinkers. The Journal received a number of papers including case comments and book

reviews. In the first review process, all submissions underwent an initial round of scrutiny followed by a plagiarism check and then the contributions were shortlisted for publication. After the process of blind-peer review, the members of the Editorial Board with assistance from the Advisory Board selected twelve papers for publication. The Journal has published scholarly articles as well as comments on recent decisions by courts, legislative analysis and review of books.
